Mrs. Kathleen "Kathie" Anne Gennari, 75, of Dalton, passed away unexpectedly with her family by her side on Friday, August 7, 2020. She was born in Pittsfield, MA on June 17, 1945 to Donald and Katherine Maloney Cullen. She graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1963.

Kathie married Angelo Gilberto Gennari on September 13, 1969. Together, they owned and operated Benny's Restaurant in Dalton for over 30 years. During this time, Kathie touched the lives of countless people through her cooking and love of conversation. Kathie and Angelo sponsored many youth and adult sports teams throughout the years. After Kathie retired from Benny's, she worked for 7 years as a medical assistant to Dr. Richard Green, MD.
