Ms. Kimberly Ann (Parrott) Kropinski passed away unexpectedly during open heart surgery late Monday evening on September 13, 2021. In life she volunteered at food pantries and did outreach for the homeless whether through a church community or just from her own desires. Her only son, Joel was her greatest gift and light in her life.
