Mrs. Andrea J. Lancia, 75, of Pittsfield, passed away at her home on Sunday, July 10, 2022, surrounded by her loving family. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on April 13, 1947, the daughter of the late George and Irene Layden Beattie, she graduated from St. Joseph's High School in 1965 and later attended classes at Berkshire Community College.

Andrea was employed by General Electric and General Dynamics for nearly 30 years, where she worked in the contracts office. She also owned AJ's Carriage House in Lanesboro where many good times were had with friends from her softball and bowling teams. 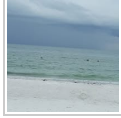
