Mrs. Ann J. Lysonski, 93, of Pittsfield died Saturday evening at Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility.

Born in Greenfield, MA, on January 17, 1919, the daughter of Peter and Dominika Rudniska Panus, she attended schools in Pittsfield and graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1937.

Mrs. Lysonski worked for the State of Massachusetts, Department of Education for many years, retiring in 1984.
