January 14, 1938 - January 3, 2024

Mrs. Ann J. Murphy, of Pittsfield, MA, passed away on Wednesday, January 3, 2024, just weeks shy of celebrating her 86th birthday. Born in Youghal, County Cork, Ireland, on January 14, 1938, the daughter of the late John and Mary O'Brien White, she attended schools in Ireland.

Ann worked as a home healthcare aide for the elderly for many years.

Among many things, she enjoyed playing mahjong, baking her famous apple pies, playing cards, watching movies, Tanglewood, trips to Cape Cod, shopping, yearly parties with friends, and taking trips to see family. She was also a member of the Irish Sister City Committee in Pittsfield.

Ann was predeceased by her beloved husband, Thomas P. Murphy, whom she married on August 17, 1963. Thomas passed away on October 16, 2003. She was also predeceased by 5 brothers and 2 sisters, all of the United Kingdom.

She is survived by her three daughters, Patricia A. Czuba and husband Jamie Czuba, of Clayton, NC, Deborah J. Murphy and Jeffrey Thomson, of Pittsfield, MA, and Lynn M. 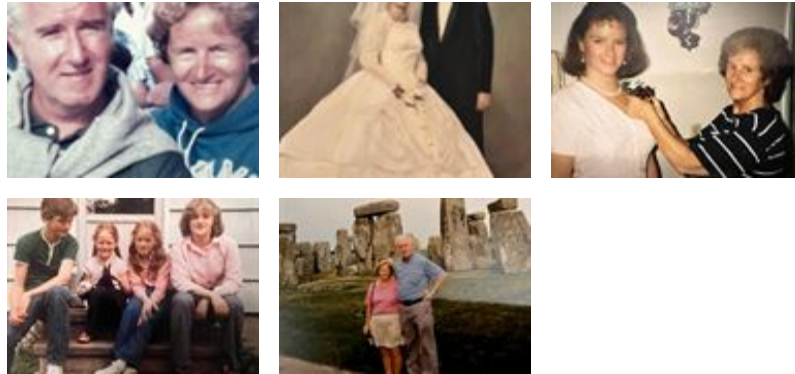
