



## Mrs. Anna "Ann" Geary

April 1, 1918 - June 12, 2015

Anna "Ann" M. Geary of 12 Richardson Street Cheshire died peacefully at home on June 12, 2015 after a long illness.

Born in Maltby, PA on April 1, 1918, Ann was the second of six beautiful daughters of Italian immigrants, Giuseppe and Mary Marby LoCascio. As a young girl, the family relocated to Pittsfield where she attended local schools. During World War II, Ann was employed at General Electric contributing to the war effort. In the early 1970's, she was employed at Riseberg's Clothing Store in Pittsfield, eventually purchasing and operating the business until retirement and moving to Florida in 1980.

She married her husband James on December 18, 1943 and after the War, moved to a new home in Lanesborough where she spent the next 30 years raising her family. In 2007, Ann and Jim relocated to the Berkshires to a new home in Cheshire, next door to son Michael and daughter-in-law Ernestine Geary.

Ann is survived by her husband of 71 years James Geary, daughters Patricia Driscoll and her husband David of Saratoga Springs, NY, Diane Magargal and her husband Steve of Worthington, sons James Geary and partner Tina Barnini of Cheshire, and Michael Geary and his wife Ernestine of Cheshire. She is also survived by sisters Julia Carey of Port St. Lucie, Florida, Jenny Ramsey, Fran Martin, Josie Pigott all of Pittsfield; 10 grandchildren, 13 great grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. She was predeceased by her sister, Dolly Parise of Pittsfield.
