Besides his parents, he was predeceased by Uncles, Aunts and a few close friends.

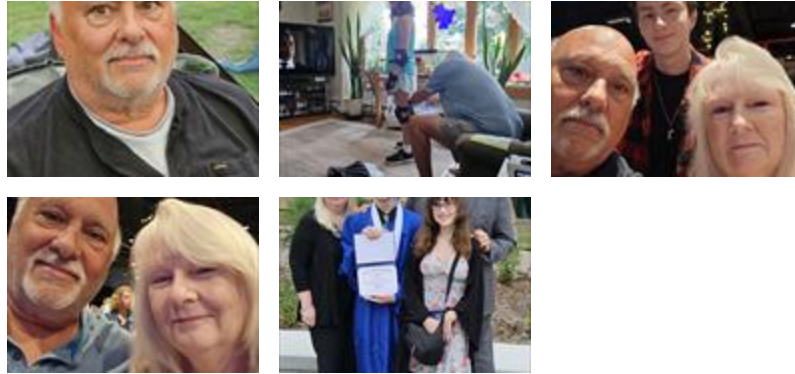
