



Mr. Anthony "Tony" Nugai

August 9, 1932 - August 27, 2013

Mr. Anthony "Tony" Nugai, 81, of 95 Longview Terrace, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, August 27, 2013 at Craneville Place of Dalton. Born in Pittsfield on August 9, 1932 the son of Charles and Camille Passerini Nugai, he was a 1951 graduate of Pittsfield High School where he was captain of the Football Team.

He was a US Navy Korean War Veteran serving from 1952 to 1956 aboard the Destroyer USS Beatty DD-756.

Mr. Nugai worked for the US Postal Service as a letter carrier for 30 years, retiring in 1988.

He was a member of the Italian American Club, the American Legion Post 68 and the Monday Morning Quarterback Club where he had been inducted into the Hall of Fame.

Tony was very involved in local sports; he coached minor league and Babe Ruth and was also manager of the Tyler Aces Baseball and Football teams.

Mr. Nugai was a communicant of the former All Soul's Church.

Tony was predeceased by his wife, Elizabeth Panetti, whom he married on March 2, 1957, she died on January 8, 2005. He is survived by a son, A. Scott Nugai and his wife Cynthia and a daughter Camille Nugai all of Pittsfield, three sisters, Helen Lincoln of Newport, RI, JoAnn Ferry of Dalton, MA, Patricia Moses of East Greenbush, NY and John Nugai of Irving, TX, Thee granddaughter, Katherine A. Nugai and several nieces and nephews.
