



## Miss Antoinette T. Schiavone

October 22, 1921 - April 23, 2024

Miss Antoinette Theresa Schiavone formerly of Pittsfield died peacefully on April 23, 2024, at age 102 at The Landing at Laurel Lake in Lee, MA.

Born in Pittsfield on October 22, 1921, she was the daughter of Leone and Maria Concetta Iorio Schiavone. A June 1939 graduate of Pittsfield High School, she also attended the former Berkshire Business College.

Miss Schiavone was an employee of the former General Electric Company's Transformer Business Division, employed as a secretary to the Human Resources manager. She retired on January 1, 1984, after 44 years of service.

She was an avid reader, enjoyed knitting and dress making, creating many of her own designs. She was a member and volunteer of the Berkshire County Historical Society.

A sister, Mrs. Carmella M. Ricci, predeceased her on May 16, 1977, and another sister, Angeline Dastoli on January 6, 2014. She was also predeceased by a beloved nephew and godson, Stephen R. Ricci on June 2, 2013. She leaves her brother Ralph N.
