Mr. Bob DiOrio, 82, of 32 Deerfield Street, Pittsfield, died peacefully at his home on Tuesday, January 15, 2013.

Born on May 24, 1930, in Pittsfield, he was the son of the late John and Rina Curini DiOrio. A lifelong Pittsfield resident, he was educated in Pittsfield schools and a graduate of the University of Bridgeport. He served his country as a Navy Corpsman assigned to the Marine Corps. Mr. DiOrio was employed by General Electric Naval Ordnance Systems for over 27 years. He retired in 1988.
