continue to fight through the hard times. He leaves his stepson, Gavin, and Danielle, the mother of their children.

Brian is also survived by his parents, Ronald and Patricia Bordeau, sister Renee and husband Jason, and niece and nephew, Caitlin and Mitchell Hall, along with his in-laws, Sal and Karen Caccavalle and many aunts, uncles and cousins.
