Mr. Brian K. Hunt, 55, of Stephentown NY, passed away on Thursday, July 11, 2024, after a brief, yet courageous battle with brain cancer. He was born in Hudson NY, on January 16, 1969, the son of Edward Hunt and Noreen Ford. Upon his graduation from New Lebanon High School in 1987 he enlisted in the United States Air Force and proudly served his country in the Gulf War. Brian was honorably discharged in 1991.

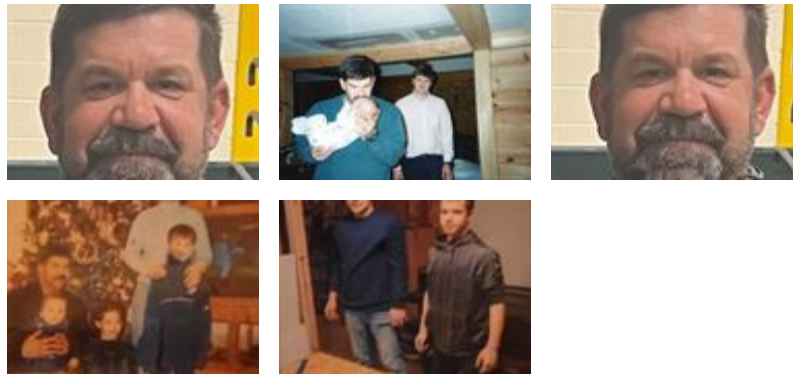
