



## Mr. Bruce A. Shepardson

May 7, 1935 - February 19, 2026

Bruce A. Shepardson, 90, of Pittsfield, passed away on Thursday, February 19, 2026.

Born in Pittsfield, MA on May 7, 1935, son of the late Lester A. and Rose E. O'Donnell Shepardson, he was a 1953 graduate of Pittsfield High School. He attended the University of Massachusetts and was an honor graduate of the General Electric Drafting Apprenticeship Course.

Mr. Shepardson was employed at General Electric as a draftsman and engineering technician for 37 years, retiring in 1991.

Mr. Shepardson had a lifelong interest in aviation, flying control line models as a teenager, held a private pilot's license for 15 years and flew radio control planes since 1980. He was a member of the Berkshire R/C Flying Club of Pittsfield.

He served 6 years in the Massachusetts National Guard.

Bruce was active in the Civil Air Patrol for many years and held various positions including Mission Pilot and Squadron Commander in Pittsfield.

He was a communicant of Sacred Heart Church.

His first wife, Patricia E. McCollum, passed away on July 28, 1995, and he was also predeceased by his sons, Brian and Patrick.

He leaves his second wife, the former Susan Parker Brown, whom he married on May 2, 1997, a sister Jean Blumenfeld of Bloomfield, CT, and son Kevin B. Shepardson and wife Mary of Pittsfield. He is survived by daughter-in-law Elizabeth Shepardson, as well as 4 grandchildren, Noah and Adam Shepardson, Amelia and Lindsey Brown, and two stepsons Stephen and wife Denise and Aaron Brown and wife Cheryl.
