Miss Camilla "Cim" Parker Smith, age 82, of Canaan, N.Y. died on Sunday, August 5, 2012 at her home. She was born in Pittsfield, November 20, 1929, the daughter of the late Capt. Sydney R. and Marjorie S. Parker Smith. She was educated at St. Agnes School for Girls in Albany, N.Y. and Blackstone College for Girls in Blackstone, VA. Ms Smith was the Editor of Harper Magazine in New York City until the death of her Father in 1964 when she returned to Canaan to assist her Mother in operating Smith Sporting Books as an Equestrian Antique Book Dealer.
