Mrs. Carmella Discoe, 86, of Lakeview St., passed away on Tuesday, January 27, 2015 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on January 28, 1928 the daughter of Joseph A. and Jennie B. DiMashe Monterosso, she was a 1945 graduate of Pittsfield High School.

After High School, Carmella worked for Berkshire Life Insurance for two years. She then, in 1950, earned her Nursing Degree from the Henry W. Bishop Memorial Training School for Nurses.

She married her husband, Richard, on April 7, 1951 in Mt. Carmel Church. Shortly after their wedding, she and her husband moved to Gales Ferry, CT. She worked as Director of the Gallup Men's Admission Ward at Norwich State Hospital for several years. She then moved to Illinois where she worked as the Night Supervisor at the Downey Veterans Hospital.

Carmella moved back to Pittsfield in 1964 and worked at Berkshire Medical Hospital as a Float Nurse until 1976. She then worked at Neighborhood Health Center as Associate Director until her retirement in 1990.

She was a member of the Henry W. Bishop Alumnae, the St. Joseph Indian Reservation, Berkshire County Arc and a communicant of St. Charles Church.

Mrs. Discoe leaves her husband of 64 years, Richard E. Discoe; two daughters, April Ann Discoe-Keough and her husband Bruce and Pamela Jean Discoe Garwood, all of Pittsfield; two grandchildren, Kalie Monterosso Garwood and Richard Discoe Garwood.
