Mrs. Carol Monti Nichols, 58, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully on Saturday, February 24, 2018 after a courageous battle with ALS. Born in Pittsfield on September 20, 1959 the daughter of Patricia Roberts Monti and the late Ettore Monti, she was a 1977 graduate of Taconic High School. Mrs. Nichols worked for the City of Pittsfield managing the IT Department at City Hall for 18 years, retiring in 2017. She had previously worked at Berkshire Mutual Insurance Company and Beloit Fiber Systems.

Carol was on the Board of Directors of MyCom Federal Credit Union. She volunteered for many local charity organizations and was especially involved in Big Brothers Big Sisters.

An avid golfer, Carol was a longtime member of the Wahconah Country Club where she was two-time Club Champion.

Carol was small in stature but had a huge heart. She was a dedicated worker and had an infectious smile. She enjoyed trips to Fenway to see the Red Sox and having fun with family and friends, especially on St. Patrick's Day.

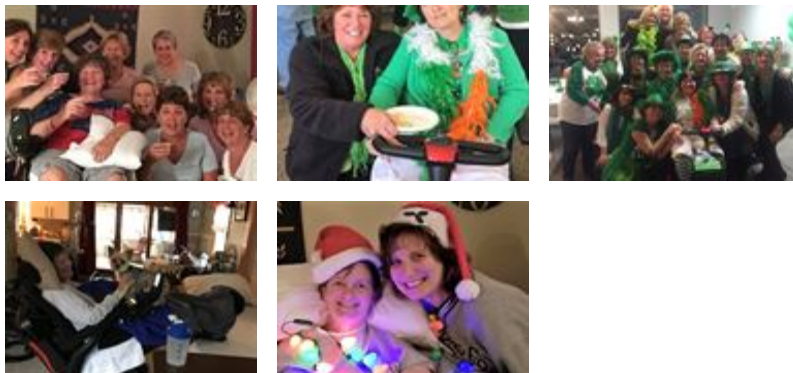

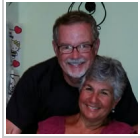
