Mrs. Caroline F. Zahn, 92, of Richmond, formerly of Pittsfield, MA and New Lebanon, NY, passed away on Wednesday, December 23, 2015 at Craneville Place of Dalton. Born in North Adams on August 15, 1923 the daughter of Harold and Marion Kelleher Durkee, she was a graduate of St. Joseph High School, St. Luke's School of Nursing and St. Vincent's School of Anesthesia. 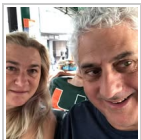
