



Mrs. Catherine A. Mlynarczyk

December 12, 1932 - October 16, 2023

Mrs. Catherine A. Mlynarczyk, of Pittsfield, passed away on Monday October 16, 2023, just months shy of celebrating her 91st birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on December 12, 1932, the daughter of the late Victor and Catherine (Pyrzanowski) Mierzejewski, she graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1950. On November 22, 1952, she married the love of her life, Edward K. Mlynarczyk of Pittsfield. They went on to have three sons before his untimely death in 1965.

Catherine worked as a Teacher's Aide in the Pittsfield schools before going to work for General Electric/Lockheed Martin. She retired from Lockheed Martin after 25+ years of dedicated service.

Catherine was very involved with the Polish Falcons of America. For many years she taught Polish Folk Dancing, Drill and Gym Classes at the local nest. She was also involved at the National Level as Director of her district. Catherine was proud of her Polish Heritage and worked tirelessly with the local youth to pass on her passion for her heritage.

Catherine is survived by her three sons, Edward (Lisa), Ernest (Robin) of Pittsfield and Joseph (Victoria) of South Bend/Indiana and her grandchildren Nicholas, Matthew and Luke Mlynarczyk, Kate Teutsch as well as two bonus grandchildren Lindzy and Travis Wise.

Besides her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her brother Richard Mierzejewski and Sister Rita Egan.
