Christian John Vonberg, of Hinsdale, MA, passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, January 5, 2021, just days shy of his 23rd birthday. He is survived by his older sister Kayla Vonberg, twin brother and best friend Specialist Casey Vonberg of the United States Army, younger sister Kylee Vonberg, and

younger brother Wolfgang Vonberg. Christian also leaves behind his maternal grandparents, Shirley and Charles Cleveland, his nieces, Riley Vonberg, Evelyn Sanford and Noelle Beckett, nephew Milo Vonberg, and many cousins, uncles, and aunts that loved him dearly.
