Dr. Clifford E. Madden of Lee, Ma and Bradenton, Fla passed away peacefully at home on October 9, 2021, just three weeks shy of his 90th birthday, with his children by his side. Born in Pittsfield on October 31, 1931, he was the son of the late Francis and Albertine (Croteau) Madden. 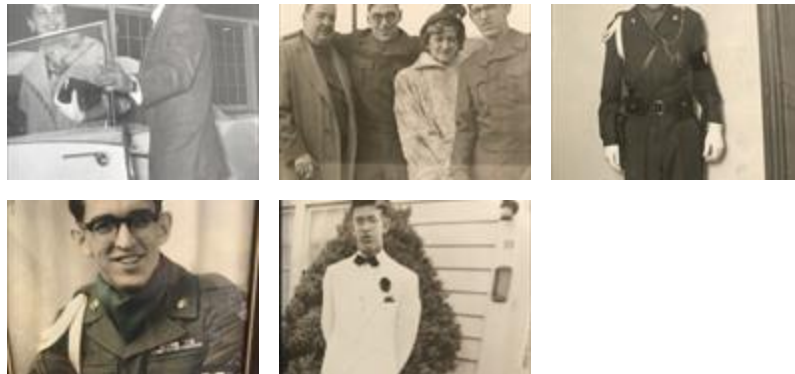
