Mr. Dale Joseph Baity, 59, of Summit Rd., Richmond, passed away peacefully on Wednesday November 12, 2014, at his home, surrounded by his loving family after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

Born April 21, 1955 at Fort Riley, KS, he was the son of Sgt. 1st Class Joseph A. Baity and Ella Gebauer Baity.
