Daniel M. Kelly, 60, of 185 Lebanon Mountain Rd., Pittsfield, formerly of 448 Bridge Rd., Florence, MA, died Thursday evening at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Turners Falls, MA on May 20, 1951 the son of James E. and Henrietta Guminak Kelly, he was a 1969 graduate of Northampton High School in Northampton, MA.

Mr. Kelly was a US Army Vietnam Veteran, enlisting in September of 1969. He was a trained US Army Parachutist and on the Rescue Ski Patrol while stationed in Germany. He received the National Defense Service Medal and the Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal.

He worked as a painter for many years, employed by several painting contractors.

Daniel enjoyed being outdoors, fishing and camping. He was a voracious reader and liked watching old movies. Daniel enjoyed children and was known to be a kid magnet. He was always laughing and enjoyed a good prank.

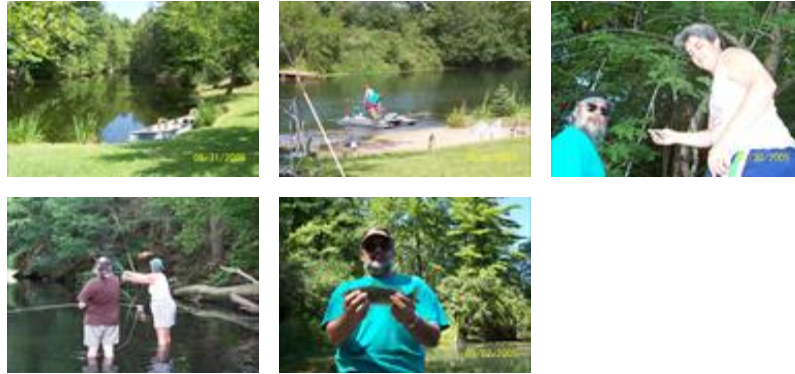
