



Mr. David "Dave" Bubriski

May 20, 1952 - April 16, 2025

Mr. David "Dave" Bubriski, of Pittsfield, passed away unexpectedly on Wednesday, April 16, 2025, just one month shy of his 73rd birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on May 20, 1952, son of the late Alexander and Virginia Serowik Bubriski, he and his sister, Christine, were raised in a close-knit Polish family and community. He graduated from St. Joseph's High School with the class of 1970. Dave went on to earn his associate's degree with a focus on environmental studies from Berkshire Community College, and later continued his education at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst.

For the majority of his career, Dave was employed by the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority. It was from there that he retired as manager after over 30 years of dedicated service. Among many things, he enjoyed golf, spending time with his beloved dog, Timmy, who died in January, and political debate. After retirement, Dave became active in the community including past-president of Civitan of the Berkshires, and the Berkshire County Republican Party even earning the distinction of Republican of the Year and was always happy to help a friend or family member in need.

Above all else, Dave was a devoted son, brother and uncle. The happiest years of his life were after his grand-niece, Alexandra, was born and he took an active role in caring for her as a baby. Dave never missed a school event, a birthday party, or opportunity to help with a science project for either Kate or

Alexandra.

David is survived by his sister, Christine Bubriski, niece Kate Powers (Josh Pepper) and their daughter, Alexandra. He also leaves his longtime companion, Darlene Proctor Wendling.

He was predeceased by his parents.

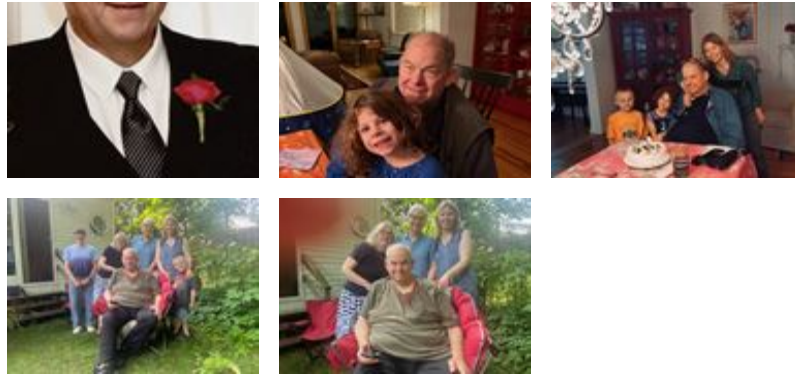
