Dorothy J. "Dody" Brady, 44, of Lanesborough passed away June 15, 2014 after a long and courageous battle with cancer. Born in Bennington, VT, February 11, 1970, the daughter of William and Alberta Moody Till, she was a 1988 graduate of Taconic High School. While there she was a member of the cheerleading squad.
