



## Mrs. Dolores "Lola" Warren

August 6, 1932 - July 9, 2025

Dolores "Lola" Warren, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, July 9, 2025, surrounded by her loving and devoted family. She was just weeks away from celebrating her 93rd birthday. Born in Pittsfield on August 6, 1932, Lola was the daughter of the late Marziale and Catherine Zaffino Carlopoli. A graduate of Pittsfield High School's Class of 1950, she later pursued coursework at Wayne Community College.

Lola built a long and dedicated career at General Electric, where she worked as a production clerk for three decades before retiring her first time. During that time she served in several union positions for Local Union #254. She then proceeded to work over 20 years as a part-time legal secretary in her son's office where she retired for a second time 2020.

A woman of vibrant spirit and many interests, she enjoyed traveling—especially trips to the casino—and never turned down a game of Bocce or Pitch. She also found joy in knitting, yoga and staying active in her community.

After returning to Pittsfield from Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, where her husband Kenneth was stationed, Lola became deeply involved in several local organizations. She was a member of the former Mt. Carmel Ladies Guild, St. Ann's Sodality, the Mt. Carmel Food Pantry, and held leadership roles in the Sons of Italy Lodge #564, where she was elected Treasurer in 2024. She was

also active in the Italian American Club, the GE Quarter Century and Pensioners Club, and the Pittsfield Civitans.

Lola was preceded in death by her beloved husband of nearly 56 years, Kenneth G. Warren, Sr., whom she married on August 2, 1955. He passed on February 19, 2011. She was also predeceased by her siblings—Theresa Wyand, Mary Girard, Nancy Costa, and Carmen Carlopoli—and her cherished grandchildren, Stacey and Jake Kratka.

She is survived by her children, Kenneth G. Warren, Jr. and Katrina Kratka (Lawrence); her grandson, Jeremy Kratka (Brittany); and her step-grandchildren Shayne Marquis and Lizzie Warren. She also leaves behind her brothers, John Carlopoli and Marziale Carlopoli (Kimberly), along with many nieces and nephews, each of whom held a special place in her heart.

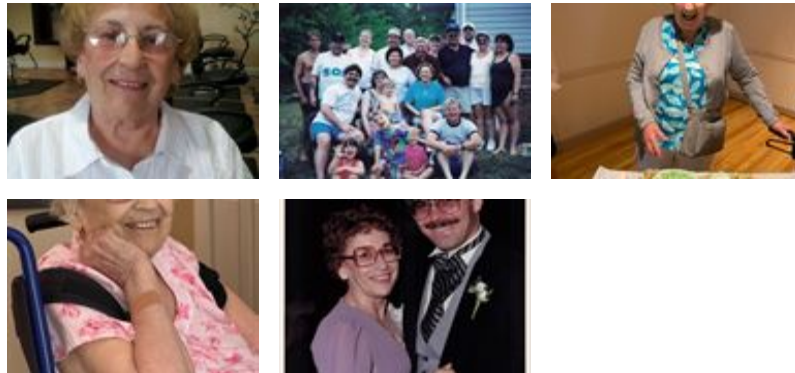
