Mr. Dominic A. Juliano, 26, of Pittsfield, MA, passed away on Saturday, July 12, 2025, at Cooley Dickinson Hospital in Northampton, from injuries sustained in an accident.

Born in Pittsfield on September 18, 1998, Dominic was the beloved son of Jeremy and Nichole (Parker) Juliano. He graduated from Wahconah Regional High School in 2016 and later attended MCLA. Dominic was employed as the manager of NAPA Auto Parts on Merrill Road, where his leadership and friendly spirit earned him the respect of many.

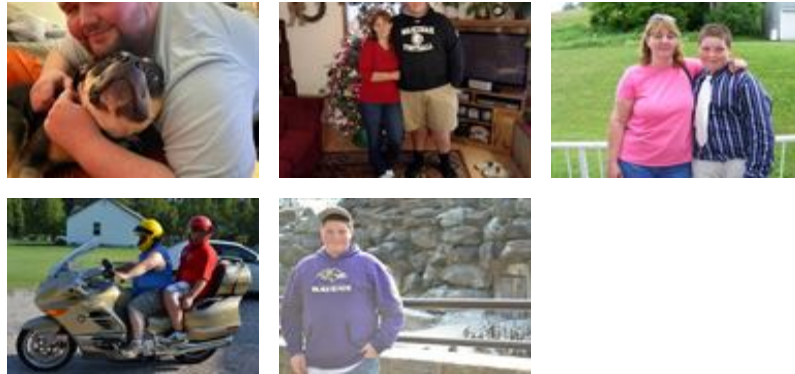
