Mr. Donald A. McIntyre, 84, passed away on Thursday May 19, 2016, at home. Born in Pittsfield on June 27, 1931, son of Neil McIntyre, he attended Crane School and graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1949.

Mr. McIntyre was a 20 year veteran of the U.S. Air Force, serving as a flight technician. He also served in Vietnam during that time.

After his retirement from the Air Force, he became employed by the City of Pittsfield. He worked at the Wastewater Treatment Plant until his retirement after 23 years. Mr. McIntyre also held numerous bartending jobs over the years, including the American Legion, The VFW and the Elks Club. At one time he was also employed as a security guard at Hillcrest Hospital's Detox center.
