Edith M. Fagley, 91, of Grove Ave. Lanesborough, MA, died Saturday, December 22, 2012 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield MA. Edith was born in Pittsfield on August 25, 1921 to Joseph and Mabel Ruel. She graduated from Pittsfield High School in 1938, was trained as a draftsman at General Electric before becoming a homemaker and raising six children. Edith resided most of her life in Lanesborough MA after her marriage to Haven C. Fagley on November 15, 1941 and celebrated 62 years together. She is survived by her eldest and youngest sons, Haven L. Fagley, 70, and his wife Jane of North Adams MA and her son, Gil J. Fagley, 45, of Lanesborough MA. Her surviving daughters are Patricia A Shands of Chesapeake, VA, Peggy A Morse of Stockbridge, MA and Berta A Fagley of Pittsfield, MA. She leaves behind nine grandchildren, nine great-grandchildren and one great-great-grandchild, Aliviana.

She is predeceased by her husband Haven C Fagley, her oldest daughter Judith and her grandson Bryan Gajdarik. She was also predeceased by her sister Mabel Kirchner and brothers Raymond and Joseph Ruel.

Edith has spent the last two years working on her “bucket list” which her family calls “Edith’s Excellent Adventures” which include two tandem skydives this year at 90 and 91 years of age.
