Mrs. Edith R. Mazzer, 97, of Pittsfield, passed away at her home on Sunday, November 21, 2021. Born in Great Barrington, MA, on January 16, 1924, the daughter of the late Battista and Maria Zanzi Georgis, she graduated from the former Searles High School in Great Barrington with the class of 1943.

For the majority of her career, Edith worked as a steno typist for General Electric, from where she retired in 1954. Edith also served as a clerk at the voting polls for many years.

Edith was extremely active in the community. She was a member of the Berkshire Hills Country Club, the Catholic Daughters of America, the Quarter Century Club, and the GE Pensioner's Club. She was the captain of the Ridgeway Crime Watch and catered the 10th Hole for 28 years with her husband Ed. Edith was Berkshire County's oldest cancer survivor and led the American Cancer Society's annual Relay for Life for many years.

Among many things, she enjoyed cooking and keeping up her home. Edith loved to be outdoors, especially when taking a stroll or playing a round of golf.

Edith was predeceased by her beloved husband of nearly 53 years, Edward C. Mazzer, whom she married on October 11, 1947. Edward passed away on October 4, 2000. Edith is survived by her extended family.
