

Mr. Edward "Ted" Flynn

April 18, 1937 - January 27, 2016

Mr. Edward J. "Ted" Flynn, 78, of Sarasota, FL, formerly of Pittsfield, MA passed away on January 27, 2016 in Sarasota, surrounded by his loving family. Born in Pittsfield on April, 18, 1937 the son of the late Edward M. and Mary McCarty Flynn, he was a 1955 graduate of St. Joseph High School. A Printer and Mailer by profession, he was employed initially with Printing & Mailing and later co-owned the former Berkshire Mail Room. Upon its sale, he became employed in 1986 with the Berkshire Eagle as a manager of its commercial mailing department. He retired in 2002.

He was a communicant of St. Joseph Church and a former communicant of St. Teresa's Church. He was also a communicant of Church of Incarnation in Sarasota, FL. He was a member of the Elks Club Lodge #272 in Pittsfield and a former member of the National Exchange Club.

His first wife of 37 years, the former Barbara A. Halley, died November 27, 1996. He is survived by his second wife, Mary E. "Monnie" (Garzone) whom he married September 23, 2000; two sons, James M. Flynn and William Flynn, both of Pittsfield; two daughters, Jean Clemons of Pittsfield and Patricia Kosior of Watervliet, NY; a sister, Mary Ellen Daury of Pittsfield; two step-sons, Paul Rodhouse Jr. of Hinsdale, MA and David Rock of Palm Harbor, FL; two step-daughters, Christine Shunamon of Pittsfield and Paula Belot of Hinsdale, 8 grandchildren, 7 step-grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren.

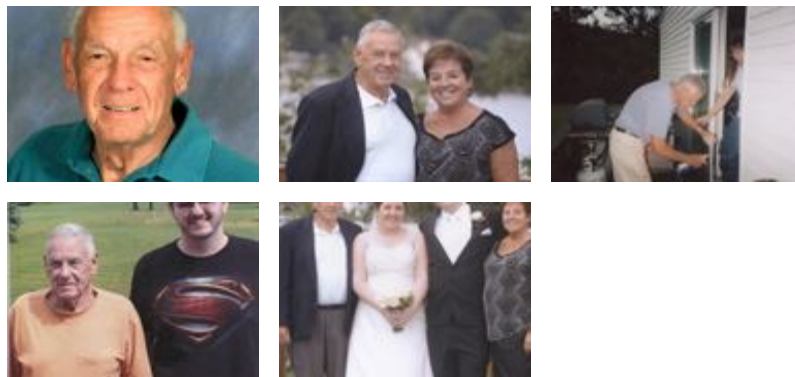
