Mr. Edward Kozlowski, 84, of 68 Wilson St., passed away Saturday, May 24, 2014 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Cieciora, Poland on August 3, 1929 the son of Stanislaw Kozlowski Sr. and Wladyslawa Serowik Kozlowski he moved to Pittsfield with his family in 1948 and graduated from Pittsfield High School.

Mr. Kozlowski was a US Army Veteran having served in Korea. He was discharged in 1953 with the rank of Corporal.

He worked as an assembler for Beloit Jones Corporation for many years, retiring in 1993.
