



Mr. Edward Mastalerz

June 27, 1918 - June 25, 2015

Edward Mastalerz (96) of Port St. Lucie, FL passed away on June 25, 2015 two days before his 97th birthday. He moved to Port St. Lucie in 1980 after living in Pittsfield and West Dennis, MA. He was born in Pittsfield, MA to John and Agatha Slosek Mastalerz. He was a graduate of Pittsfield High School and educated at Renselaer Polytechnic Institute. He was employed by the General Electric Company and retired after 39 years of service. He was a long standing member and was elected as a two term Vice President of the Berkshire Hills Country Club in Pittsfield.

Mr. Mastalerz served in the U.S. Navy, during WWII and was aboard the USS LST 522, in the English Channel, during the D-Day Invasion. He continued his service to the United States assigned to B24 patrols in Europe. He was a member of the American Legion Post 318 in Port St Lucie. He loved the game of golf and was fortunate to experience a hole-in-one in his life. He continued to play with friends in Florida up until this year.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Marjorie Bowlby Mastalerz, in 2006, to who he was married 57 years. A sister, Sophie Kulas and a brother, Matthew Mastalerz both of Pittsfield also predeceased Mr. Mastalerz. He is survived by several nieces and nephews. He also leaves behind many friends in his Port St Lucie "family". Two close friends in particular are Shirley Dias and Heinz Altenburger.
