



Mr. Edward "Ed" Turner

February 19, 1931 - February 6, 2024

Mr. Edward Earl Turner, of Dalton, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, February 6, 2024, just two weeks before celebrating his 93rd birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on February 19, 1931, he was the son of the late Edgar and Mildred Higgins Turner. He graduated from Dalton High School in 1949, and later from the Stockbridge School of Agriculture at the University of Massachusetts. He served our country in the Army Medical Corp from 1952-1954.

For most of his career, Ed was employed by the Berkshire County Surveying Department. It was there he dedicated 23 ½ years until his retirement in 1991.

Ed was an active part of his community. He spent many years with the Windsor 4H Club and Fair Society. Most of his life he enjoyed serving the Lord by helping his fellowmen to have a better outlook on life. He enjoyed many years worshipping the Lord at the Berkshire First Church of the Nazarene.

Edward was predeceased by his beloved wife of 67 years, the former Janwell "Jan" Sherman, whom he married on September 16, 1955. Jan passed away in February of 2023.
