



## Ms. Eleanor "Ellie" Carver

September 19, 1933 - August 13, 2023

Eleanor "Ellie" Ducharme Carver, 89, of Dalton, MA., passed away on Sunday, August 13, 2023, surrounded by her family. Born in Northampton, MA, on September 19, 1933, the daughter of the late Arthur and Victoria Ducharme, Ellie graduated from Huntington High School in 1951. She lived in Worthington from birth until 1956 and resided in Dalton from 1956 until her passing.

Ellie worked for GE in Pittsfield from 1951 to 1958, then again from 1968 to 1972, for Crane & Co. from 1972 until retiring in 1996, and later for T.J. Maxx from 2002 until 2017.

In high school she was an outstanding basketball player and sports person. She continued playing basketball and softball for Pro Drug and Majestic in Pittsfield. At the age of 12 she took up golf at the Worthington Golf Club and became an accomplished golfer in Berkshire County. She was also a member of Wahconah, Berkshire Hills and GEAA country clubs, winning 24 Club Championships, 2 Berkshire County Championships, many 2-ball tournaments, Allied Mixed Championships, had 2 hole-in-ones and currently holds the record with 9 Allied Championships.

She was an avid bowler at the Dalton Community House and American Legion for many years. She was a member of Dalton Methodist Church.

Ellie enjoyed walking, gardening, spending time with her family and playing golf.

Ellie leaves a daughter Sharon Winsett of Pittsfield., three sons: Wayne Carver (Dawn Forbes) of Windsor, Steven Carver (Joanne) of Winchester, VA., and George Carver Jr.(Karen) of Tucson, AZ. She also leaves 6 grandchildren: Matthew and Kristin Winsett and Jacob, Haley, Zachary and Stephanie Carver, 3 great grandchildren: Samuel Winsett, Vance, and Dylan Carver.

She was predeceased by her brother, Arthur Ducharme.
