Mrs. Eleanor H. Keegan, 88, of 6 Myrtle St., Pittsfield, died Wednesday June 8, 2011 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on July 28, 1922 the daughter of Francis J. and Catherine Forrest Hughes she was a 1939 graduate of St. Joseph's High School and later studied Biology at the College of St. Rose in Albany, NY.

Mrs. Keegan was Executive Director of the Berkshire County Chapter of the American Heart Association for 12 years retiring in 1985. She also volunteered at the Berkshire Museum and Tanglewood.

She was an avid painter, loved antiques and enjoyed classical music.
