



## Eugenie "Genie" Kennedy

August 31, 1956 - February 16, 2017

Eugenie "Genie" H. Kennedy of Plymouth, MA, died peacefully at her home on Thursday, February 16, 2017 after a brief illness. Born in Pittsfield MA, she was the daughter of the late Mary Murray Kennedy and Eugene Kennedy from Co. Galway, Ireland.

Genie graduated from St. Joseph's High School in 1974, received an Associates degree from Berkshire Community College in 1976, and graduated from North Adams State College in 1979 with a BS in Business Administration, concentrating in Accounting.

Genie began her career in 1979 at Berkshire Housing in Pittsfield, MA, starting as a part-time bookkeeper and leaving as Vice President of Finance. In 1987, she moved to eastern Massachusetts and joined the Arbor Group. Her role within the company changed as the organization grew and expanded, and she eventually became President of Arbor Management in Marshfield, MA. Genie was a dedicated entrepreneur who devoted her life to her work, and her employees became like family to her.

Genie loved her niece and nephews, Nick and Chris Turloukis and Declan and Katie Bell, and spent many hours laughing, traveling, and cooking with them. She always enjoyed spending time with family, especially around the Thanksgiving table. She spent much of her time engaged in political discussions and snuggling with her two dogs, Zach and Zeke. Genie was also a devoted Patriots fan, and was thrilled to get to see them win Super Bowl LI. Besides her niece and nephews, Genie leaves her sister, Patricia Kennedy

Bell of Saunderstown, RI, and her 2 brothers-in-law, Vas Turloukis of Amherst, MA, and Daniel Bell. She was predeceased by her sister, Margaret "Peg" Kennedy Turloukis.
