Evelyn Miller, 101, passed away on Monday, January 26, 2026, at the home of her daughter and son-in-law. Born on November 13, 1924, daughter of the late Louis and Mary Jane Garrity Greenleaf, she graduated from St. Luke's Training School where she earned her R.N. degree.
