



## Dr. Frank Moore Faucett

April 26, 1923 - June 11, 2016

Dr. Frank Moore Faucett, 93, passed away on Saturday, June 11, 2016 at Mt. Greylock Extended Care Facility.

Born in New Haven, CT, April 26, 1923 the son of Frank M. Faucett and Cecelia Hart Faucett, he attended the local schools there graduating from New Haven High School. He also graduated from St. John's Preparatory School in Danvers, MA. Continuing his education, he graduated from Pennsylvania College of Optometry in 1944.

Drafted during WWII, he served in the US Army Infantry in the Medical Corps during the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded the Bronze Star for his service there.

Following the war, Dr. Faucett opened his own private practice in Optometry on Tyler St. He retired after 30 years.

A communicant of Sacred Heart Church, he was Grand Knight and head of the local chapter of the Knights of Columbus for several years, a member of the Exchange Club, and was a volunteer at the Norman Rockwell Museum for many years.

He and his wife, the late Patricia Lynch Faucett, were married in Kingston,

Jamaica, West Indies at Holy Cross Church in 1961 by a close Jesuit friend. She died May 7, 2013.

He is survived by his sister in law, Palma Fleck of Richmond, and his dear friends, David & Maureen Quinlan of Pittsfield. He was predeceased by a brother in law, James Anthony Lynch.
