



Mr. Frederic Trzcinka

July 1, 1935 - November 30, 2025

Mr. Frederic Trzcinka, 90, of Pittsfield, passed away at his home on Sunday, November 30, 2025. Born in Housatonic, MA, on July 1, 1935, son of the late Ben and Stella Nosek Trzcinka, he graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1954 and later, in 1973, from Clarkson University with his degree in Industrial Engineering

Shortly after high school, Fred enlisted in the United States Marines. He proudly served his country beginning in 1957 and was honorably discharged as a Corporal in 1960, though, as the saying goes--“Once a Marine, Always a Marine”!

For the majority of his career, Fred was employed by General Electric, where he worked in their Ordnance Department. It was from there that he retired after over 30 of dedicated service.

Among many things, Fred’s family (German Shepards included!) was of utmost importance to him. He was a man of faith and lived his life accordingly. Fred was an active volunteer for St. Mark’s Church and also enjoyed donating his time to The Red Cross, Meals on Wheels, and Hurricane Relief.

Fred is survived by his beloved wife of 57 years, the former Roberta Robert, whom he married August 24, 1968. He leaves behind his sister, Barbara

Conway (Robert), brother-in-law, Tony Venturini, and niece Patty Janchuk. Fred is also survived by many in the Robert family, and numerous cousins, nieces and nephews, all of whom held a special place in his heart.

Besides his parents, he was predeceased by his sisters, Theresa Venturini and Patricia Trzcinka.
