



## Mrs. Gale Stanton Crane

October 11, 1938 - February 25, 2024

Mrs. Gale Stanton Crane, 85, of Dalton, passed away on Sunday, February 25, 2024. Born in Scranton, PA on October 11, 1938, she was the daughter of the late Sterling and Adeline Ross Stanton. Gale was a 1956 graduate of Abington Heights High School and attended Syracuse University the following year. While there she met her future husband, Christopher Murray Crane. They were married in May of 1958 and settled down in his hometown of Dalton, MA.

Gale and Chris soon had two sons, David and Douglas, and a few years later their daughter Allison arrived to keep them all in line. Gale was a devoted mother and wife, volunteering for school functions, watching sports, and always there to greet her children when they returned home for the day. She was an avid reader, and volunteered for many years at "The Quiet Corner" in Lenox, a haven for authors, readers and stimulating discussion run by her good friend Eve Perrera. She also devoted a lot of time to "Just a Second" thrift shop, whose proceeds benefitted Berkshire Country Day School. She enjoyed gardening and was a long time member of the Garden Club of America, growing both flowers and vegetables, a love she learned from her father Sterling and passed on to her children and grandchildren.

Gale also loved the ocean, especially snorkeling. Annual family trips to Osterville on Cape Cod were always a highlight, and in later years she and

Chris would spend time in Bermuda, St John, or Grand Cayman during the winter, exploring the coral, fish and beach walks.

Gale was predeceased by her beloved husband of 57 years, Christopher Murray Crane. Chris passed away on February 19, 2016. Following his death, she moved into Kimball Farms Independent Living in Lenox, where she was well cared for, enjoyed the activities and was known for her friendly demeanor with all she encountered. The family is most grateful for the care and love she received.

She is survived by her daughter, Allison Crane of Egremont and her son Charles Guyer; son Douglas and his wife Becky Crane of Dalton and their children Elizabeth (Mathew and their son Thomas), Andrew (Katie and children Declan and Clara), and Charlotte; son David and his wife Ruth Blodgett of Dalton and their children Christopher (Lindsey and daughter Alice), Alice (Nick) and Robin; and her brother Robert Stanton of Waimanalo, HI.
