Mr. George H. "Dick" LeClair, 86, of 1 Savoy St., Pittsfield, died Friday morning, May 10, 2013 at home. He was born in Burlington, VT on April 20, 1927 the son of George and Alice Fox LeClair. Mr. LeClair moved to Pittsfield with his parents at a young age and graduated from St. Joseph High School.
