George Ernst Ungewitter, 82, died May 8, 2015 at Mount Carmel Rehab & Nursing facility. Husband, father, brother, grandfather, great grandfather, uncle, friend, George will be missed by many.

George was a lifelong resident of Pittsfield, Massachusetts. In his early years, he was a 1950 graduate of Pittsfield High School and attended UMass Amherst. George then served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War, where he spent 14 months in Adak, Alaska as a Communication Technician. He was employed by and retired from Western Massachusetts Electric Company after 36 years. George was involved in community organizations as a member of the Free Masonry, Boy Scout patrol leader, American Legion and an advisor for Junior Achievement.

George was a musician who played in area bands, including ten years as the drummer with Eastover's Jazz quartet. George enjoyed hunting, gardening, jazz, motorcycling, woodworking, talking and telling stories and spending time with his family and grandchildren. He was very proud of refurbishing and rebuilding a '47 Indian Chief motorcycle for which he won best Indian in Show. He leaves his wife of 37 years, Regina Pelletier Ungewitter; his sister Shirley Slack; his sons Mark Ungewitter, George Scott Ungewitter, Erik Ungewitter; his daughter Laurie Grube; and step daughter Andrea DeMayo; grandchildren; great grandchildren; niece; nephews; cousins and many friends and pets.
