Mrs. Georgianna Morrissey, 81, of Dalton, passed away peacefully on Saturday, March 7, 2026. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on August 28, 1944, daughter of the late Albert and Gertrude Dingman, she graduated from New Lebanon High School with the class of 1964.

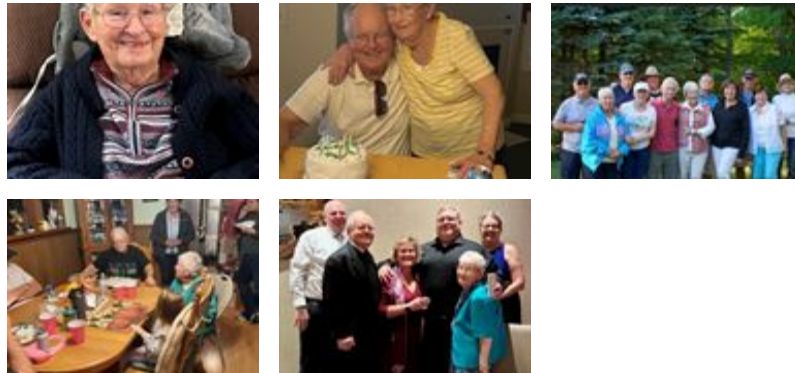
