Giuliano "Gus" Giusti, 91, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully on Sunday, March 6, 2022, at his home. Born on November 22, 1930, the son of the late Giusto and Catherina graduated from the General Electric apprentice program in 1952.

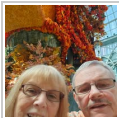
