Mr. Glenn Hoag, 82, of Melbourne Rd., Pittsfield, passed away on Monday, August 10, 2015 at Berkshire Medical Center. Born in Pittsfield on May 13, 1933 the son of William and Helen Harrington Hoag, he was a graduate of Pittsfield High School. He later studied Liberal Arts and Forestry at the University of Maine.

Mr. Hoag's college education ended prior to graduation when he was drafted into the US Army. He was a Korean War Veteran and received the National Defense Service Medal. While in the Army he served as a Radio Operator. Glenn worked for over thirty years at Pete's Motors in Pittsfield where he was Service Manager. He also owned and operated Friends Market and Liquor Store in Dalton for twelve years.
