



## Mrs. Heather Bartini

August 9, 1960 - March 11, 2022

Heather Bartini, of Pittsfield, Massachusetts, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, March 11, 2022 peacefully at her home. She was 61 at the time of her passing.

Heather was born to Francis and Virginia Scutt of Pittsfield. After graduating from Taconic High School, Heather studied Spanish in college, but found a rewarding career in the banking field. 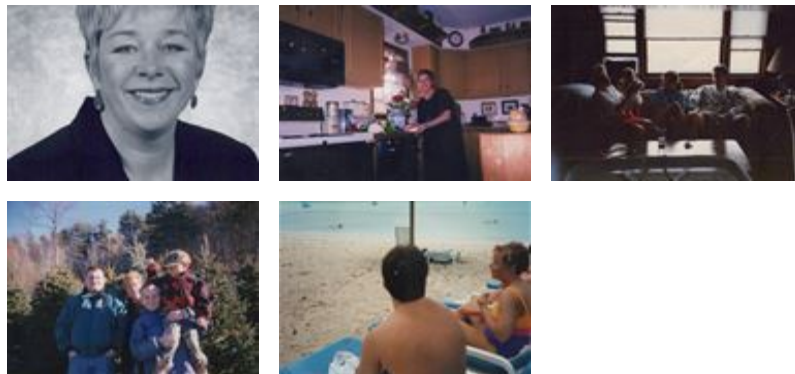
