Heidi A. Nugent, 67, passed away peacefully with her family by her side on September 10, 2016. She was born in Port Chester, NY July 14, 1949, daughter of Fred T. Hansen Jr. and Doris E. 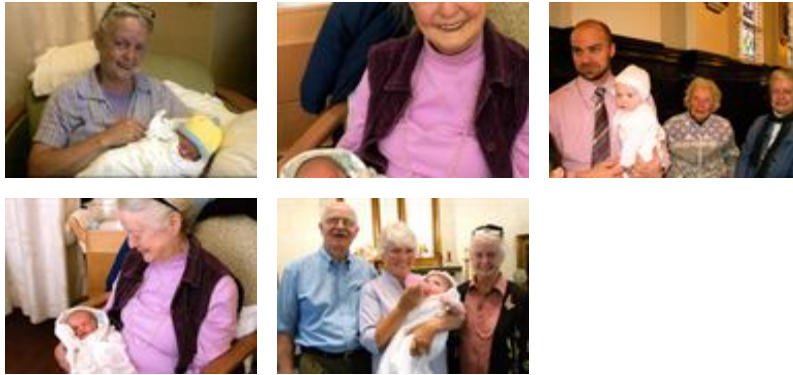
