Mr. Herbert "Mike" McGurn, of Pittsfield, passed away at his home on Tuesday, July 12, 2022, shortly after his 82nd birthday. Born in Pittsfield, MA, on June 9, 1940, the son of the late Herbert and Elizabeth Lawton McGurn, he graduated from the former St. Joseph High School and earned his associate degree from Berkshire Community College.

Mike was a Vietnam War veteran. Shortly after graduation, Mike enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he proudly served his country from 1958 to 1962.

Mike was employed by the United States Postal Service where he worked as a postal clerk. It was there he dedicated 32 years until his retirement in 1997.
