



## Mr. Hoa Chung

January 1, 1928 - October 7, 2012

Mr. Hoa Chung died quietly at Laurel Lake nursing home on October 7, 2012 at age 84. He stayed at Laurel Lake for 2 ½ years and enjoyed bingo, music, and group activities. He was visited by his children on a daily basis. He was born in Hong Kong on January 1, 1928, he grew up in Vietnam. He spoke fluently both Chinese and Vietnamese, and his parents were of Chinese descent. He was the son of Ngoc and Ly Chung. In 1947 in Saigon, he married his beloved Lai Lang who died of cancer in 1980. They had Twelve children together, all of who were born in Vietnam prior to their moving to the United States in 1984. In Vietnam, he ran a family wholesale meat business and other businesses. Mr. Hoa Chung is survived by Thuan Chung (daughter) and her husband Kuang Fu of Boston; Lam Chung (son) of Boston; Duong Chung (son) and his wife Chau , of Watertown, Connecticut; Nu Chung (daughter) of Chandler, Arizona; Thieu Chung and his wife Ming of Pittsfield; Kim Chung of Pittsfield Henry Chung and his wife Hieu (owner of Pho Saigon Restaurant in Lee) , of Pittsfield; Mui Chung (daughter) of Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam (she did not come to the United States); Jenny Chung (daughter) of Pittsfield Van Chung (son) and his wife Tram , of Chandler, Arizona, Cuong Chung (son) his wife Mui of Chandler, Arizona and Mai Chung of Pittsfield. He also is survived by 5 grandchildren, three younger sisters living in Vietnam and numerous nieces and nephews
