Mr. Hubert J. Lyng, Jr, of Pittsfield, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, February 1, 2026, just one month after celebrating his 90th birthday. Born in Summit, NJ, on January 8, 1936, son of the late Hubert and Marjorie Myrick Lyng, he graduated from Rosenville High School in Albany, NY.

Shortly after high school, Hubert enlisted in the United States Army. It was there he proudly served his country until his honorable discharge.

For the majority of his career, Hubert was employed by General Electric, and then by Lockheed Martin, where he worked as a program manager in Ordnance Department. It was from there that he retired after many years of dedicated service.

Among many things, he enjoyed a good game of bowling, and a round of golf. He also played music in several bands.
